Lesson – *“Thanking God for His Works”, Pt. 2* - Scripture: Psalm 66:1--20

- I. **Thanks is Story - \_\_\_\_\_ (Psa. 66: 5-12)**
- A. The Psalmist invited everyone who \_\_\_\_\_ the LORD to listen to what he had to say.
  - B. He wanted the \_\_\_\_\_ to listen to him because God would \_\_\_\_\_ to them.
  - C. Notice, the Psalmist shift from corporate/public praise to \_\_\_\_\_ praise.
  - D. Never let a person praise God more \_\_\_\_\_ you for you.
  - E. Thanks comes from realizing all the ways God has \_\_\_\_\_ for us—the ways he has provided in the past, today, and how He will continue to do so in the future.
    - i. \_\_\_\_\_ does this through His mercy and His grace.
  - F. Mercy could be either \_\_\_\_\_ or macro.
    - i. Mercy keeps from me the \_\_\_\_\_ I deserve.
  - G. Every person in here is a \_\_\_\_\_ case!
- II. **Thanks is Burden - \_\_\_\_\_ (Psa. 66: 13-20)**
- A. Don't tell me you are praising God and your \_\_\_\_\_ don't move.
  - B. Psa. 34 declares and ...His praise shall continually be in my \_\_\_\_\_!
  - C. Sometimes praise without \_\_\_\_\_ is only a performance.
  - D. I'm glad that God won't just bring you \_\_\_\_\_; He will bring you out!
  - E. You ought not get out of \_\_\_\_\_ until you count five blessings.
  - F. The “thanks” in the verse literally translates to the word \_\_\_\_\_. It means to “cast down,” “throw down,” or “shoot thanks.”
  - G. 1 Corinthians 1:4 tells us to be \_\_\_\_\_ for the people that God has placed in our lives.
    - i. Every \_\_\_\_\_ who comes into our lives isn't good.
  - H. We must even be thankful for the tests and trials that \_\_\_\_\_ us, purify us, and perfect us.
